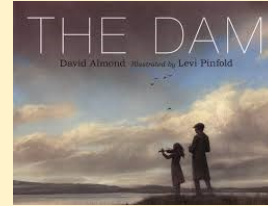


Science

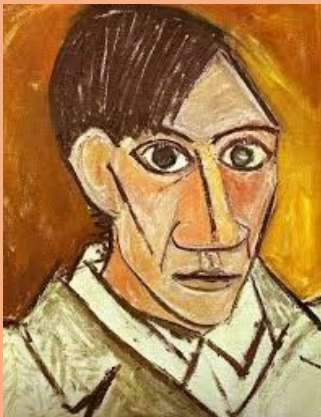
We will complete lessons around gymnastics and basketball
